AARF launches series of events for adoption and education

(AARF) is launching a series of quarterly events on Saturday, March 3, with the Friend Fur All Seasons Spring Adoption Fair. The fair will feature pets available for adoption from AARF, as well as other rescue groups in the metro Atlanta area.

Unlike many other pet adoption events, however, the focus of the Friend Fur All Seasons fair reaches beyond adoption; it's aimed at educating and supporting those who already have pets, as well. The fair will feature a wealth of information about low-cost spaying, neutering and microchips; training methods; pet health, including nutrition and massage; and care, with local pet supply stores showcasing the hottest pet toys, supplies and even couture. The fair also will provide plenty of opportunities to get involved in upcoming animal rescue events in the Atlanta area.

Among the pet supply stores and rescue groups that will be represented at the spring fair are: **Pet Park Supply, Blue Paws Bakery, Aussie Rescue and Placement Helpline of Georgia, Rescue Me! Animal Project Inc. and Spay and Neuter Team of Atlanta (SANTA).**

Those who are looking to find a furry friend at the fair will find dogs of all shapes and sizes just waiting for their "forever homes." (While cats will not be featured at the March event, cats are available for adoption through AARF, as well.) All AARF pets have been spayed or neutered, received their vaccines and rabies shots, and cats have been tested for heartworms. AARF pets are cared for in loving foster homes, where they receive love and attention, beginning training and socialization, making them adoptable and healthy companions.
